TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The **FAIRHOLME FOUNDATION 'FACETS' ACQUISITIVE AWARDS** are open to artists with a direct connection to the College (Past Student / Parent or Staff Member).
2. In addition, there will be four '**FAIRHOLME FACETS' ART AWARD** (non-acquisitive) announced at the Official Opening. NB: These awards will be selected after the Acquisitive Award has been selected.
 1. Fairholme Old Girl Art Prize (Sponsor TBA)
 2. Current Student Art Prize (Sponsor TBA)
 3. Open Art Prize (Sponsor TBA)
 4. Packers' Prize (Sponsor TBA)
3. To be eligible, all Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form and 3 jpeg images of each work to facets@fairholme.qld.edu.au by 5pm Wednesday 2 August 2017. Entries received after this date will not be accepted. All entries must include the following information:
 - Artist statement (100 words max.). This should address main themes of the **history, memories or contemporary impressions** of Fairholme College, celebrating **the life of the College**.
 - Artist's connection with the College.
 - 3 print quality jpeg images (one of these must represent the image in its entirety). Images should be less than 2MB, at least 1600 pixels wide, and able to be opened on PC format. Please ensure images are titled: Artist surname_artist first name_title of work (e.g. Smith_John_Ocean landscape). Photocopies, slides or other modes of image reproduction will not be accepted.
 - Entry Forms should be submitted as a MS Word doc or PDF. Please ensure documents are titled: Artist surname_artist first name_title of document (e.g. Smith_John_Artist's Connection). Any application that does not include the above support material will be ineligible and will not be processed.

- Whilst all reasonable care will be taken with the submitted works, the Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage that may occur before, during at the conclusion of the Exhibition. It is the responsibility of the Artist to arrange insurance to cover the work.
4. All entries will be assessed by the 'Facets of Fairholme' Selection panel, which will select a shortlist for the exhibition. All Entrants will be contacted by email and advised whether or not their entry has been shortlisted. The shortlist will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 5. The 'Facets of Fairholme' Committee recognises that the authorship and copyright of the work displayed in the final exhibition belongs to the artist.
 6. All applicants permit the 'Facets of Fairholme' Committee to reproduce biographical information and images of entered works in an exhibition catalogue and in promotional material associated with the Art Awards and Exhibition, with acknowledgement of the Artist.
 7. All Artists must arrange for delivery of their work/s to the Fairholme College Assembly Hall, Thursday 5 October – Friday 6 October, 2017, at the expense of the artist. The work delivered must be the same as the image supplied; any subsequent alterations will render the work ineligible for the Award. Artists unable to deliver the works during these timelines are asked to contact the committee prior to the Exhibition.
 8. All works must be displayed for the duration of the exhibition from Friday 13 - until 6pm on Sunday 15 October 2017. Please note: there is no facility available to store the works prior to or following the Exhibition.
 9. Fairholme College will not accept liability for any loss or damage inflicted that occurs to works during the Exhibition or in transit.
 10. All works must come professionally prepared for hanging and display (suitably framed if applicable, D-rings, as well as hanging wire). Works must be marked clearly on the back with the supplied label indicating : Artist's name, title of work and orientation (de-marked by an arrow on the back). Installation instructions must be included if necessary.
 11. All artworks must be collected between Sunday 15 Oct. 6 - 8pm or, Monday 16 Oct. 9am - 12pm 2017.
 12. All artists are encouraged to attend the Official Opening on Friday 13 October 2017 for the announcement of the Awards.
 13. The 'Facets of Fairholme' Committee reserves the right to refuse display of any entry that does not meet the requirements outlined in Terms and Conditions, or any work it deems to be unacceptable for exhibition.
 14. All works submitted for the Exhibition MUST be made available for sale. The 'Facets of Fairholme' committee will charge a 25% commission on all sales.
