Overview:

Term 1 - Instrumental Music

Through a visual and aural study of Instrumental music, students should:

- acquire knowledge and understanding of a range of instrumental music styles
- acquire knowledge of a variety of instrumental keyboard writing techniques
- develop further, skills in visual and aural analysis of studied works and problem solving using mainly studied and some unstudied works
- develop further, aural skills including notation of rhythms, melodies and cadences related to repertoire studied.
- develop further, performing skills and composing skills.

Term 2 - Keyboard Styles

Through a study of selected keyboard music, students should:

- acquire a knowledge and understanding of broad historical styles and their general music characteristics
- build basic performing skills
- develop aural skills — analysis and notation.
- develop composing skills by writing simple piano accompaniments
