

How to wear your Fairholme Uniform



Every family enrolling their daughter/s at Fairholme College receives a uniform list of what to wear. Here's HOW to wear it!

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Students must wear full school uniform to school every day. All uniform items should be clean, in good repair and named clearly.
- Full uniform, including panama, to be worn in public e.g. at shopping centres (no joggers, thongs, hair down, etc).
- Blazers are compulsory for all girls in Years 4 12 and are to be worn with full winter uniform to and from school and when wearing uniform in public.
- Correct Lengths are:
- Summer Uniform Dress to be worn with hem below the knees
- Winter Uniform Skirt to be worn mid-calf length

The College panama with hat badge must be worn to and from school each day and when students are attending excursions or school activities, unless directed otherwise. It is worn at all times outside the College grounds when in uniform.

The College bucket hat or College panama must be worn when outdoors as per the Sun Smart Policy.

- Black lace-up College shoes fashion styles are not permitted.
 No straps, t-bars or buckles.
- Shoes should be cleaned and polished and kept in good repair at all times.
- Track shoes/sports shoes should be predominantly white and have non-marking soles.

Socks and Stockings

Junior School

Summer Uniform - Navy ankle socks with turnover Winter Uniform - Navy knee-high socks with garters

Middle and Senior School

Summer Uniform - Navy ankle socks with turnover or Navy 40 denier pantyhose. Pantyhose required for formal occasions.

Winter Uniform - Navy knee-high socks with garters or Navy 40 denier pantyhose. Pantyhose required for formal occasions.

Hair

- Hair longer than the collar must be neatly tied back with hair bands and navy ribbons, or school tartan scrunchies and plain navy clips or bobby pins matching hair colour.
- Headbands must be navy or College tartan. No fashion bands are to be worn.
- Hair must be worn off the face and must be natural colour.
- All hair accessories are available from the HOLMEstore.







How to wear your Fairholme Uniform

Bags

Junior School

- Students must have either the College navy backpack or roller bag and the College navy sports bag.
- The Junior School Excursion bag is compulsory for excursions.





Middle and Senior School

- Students must have either the College navy backpack, roller bag or carry bag and the College navy sports bag.
- The College tote bag is required for excursions and for carrying books around within College grounds.
- College swimming bag is also available. No other type of bag is permitted.




Badges

- The College Badge is worn on the left collar of the summer uniform and on the left blazer lapel with the winter uniform.
- The House Badge is worn on the right collar of the summer uniform and on the right blazer lapel with the winter uniform.
- All Leadership badges are worn above the College Badge.
- The Name Badge is worn above the House Badge on the right collar of the summer uniform and on the right blazer lapel with winter
- Charity badges are only to be worn for the duration of the campaign.



The Sports Uniform, including bucket hat, must be worn for PE and sports training.





- No rings, necklaces or bracelets may be worn.
- Only ONE pair of small gold or silver studs or sleepers may be worn. If ears are double pierced, only ONE earring may be worn in each ear and only in the earlobe. No pearl or gemstone studs.
- A plain watch with a gold, silver, navy, black or tan band may be worn.
- No make-up or nail polish is to be worn.
