Dear Fairholme Junior Parents

We have appreciated your support and preparedness to respond to almost daily adjustments during this time. To those families who have been in a position to have children at home; this has enabled much stronger practice around social distancing – an imperative measure in reducing risk of transmission. The Government continues to encourage parents to keep their children at home should they so wish.

For children of essential workers – namely Health Professionals, Emergency Service workers: ambulance, fire and police, as well as parents who are in employment but who do not have the capacity to work from home, Fairholme Junior School will offer supervision of girls from Kindy to Year 6 for Monday through Thursday of next week. This mirrors the supervision provision that has been offered by the Fairholme Middle and Senior Schools.
