BUSINESS REGULATIONS for private lessons

- Under the 2016 pricing schedule, music lessons are charged at the Music Teachers' Association of Queensland (Inc) rate of \$34.00 per half hour. Shared lessons (2 students) may be available at \$22.50 per half hour, only where compatible lesson partners are found (not available on piano). These prices are reviewed annually.
- Fees for Visiting Teachers are to be paid directly to the Visiting Teacher and are due within 14 days of receipt of the account. If payment is unable to be made within this timeframe, parents / guardians are required to contact the relevant Visiting Teacher in writing (eg email) to discuss the situation and to negotiate an amicable solution. In such circumstances, lessons may be suspended until payment is received.
- At least fifteen (15) lessons per semester are provided by full-time Music Staff.
- Lessons with salaried Music Staff will be charged to your college account for 15 lessons per semester.
- Lessons are scheduled in negotiation with parents & students. Some times may be available outside school hours, but priority will be given to senior students and those taking multiple specialist lessons. During school time, lessons are rotated, in accordance with College policy, to avoid the same lessons being missed each week.
- Some Visiting Teachers are able to provide lessons before and after school.
- One half term's written notice must be given for students wishing to discontinue lessons.
- Please inform the relevant Teacher directly (a text message will suffice) before 7.30am if lesson will be missed due to illness. Catch-up lessons will be arranged at the teacher's discretion. Lessons missed without notice will be forfeited.
- Lessons commence at 7.30am each Monday to Friday, with no lessons occurring after 5.30pm.
- All students require a Music Record Book for each instrument learnt. These are available from Arts Reception at a cost of \$7.50 each.

Instrument Hire

- We will be supplying our daughter with an instrument

The College provides a full range of band and orchestral instruments for hire to students who are enrolled for lessons and participating in College ensembles. The Instrumental Hire program relies on the annual 'recycle' of College instruments (particularly for the Junior School beginner programs). The cost of renting a College instrument is \$45.00 a term and the levy will be charged to your College account. Instruments hired through the 'Instrument Hire Scheme' fall into one of three categories:

Category 1 Short Term Hire - on hire for a maximum of twelve months:

Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Bass Guitar

Category 2 Long Term Hire - on hire for a maximum of three years:

Tenor Saxophone, Oboe, French Horn, Euphonium, Violin, Viola, 'Cello, Double Bass

Category 3 On a permanent hire (by negotiation with the Head of Performance Music, for the duration of enrolment):

Piccolo, Alto Flute, Alto Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Baritone Saxophone, Bassoon, Tuba

It is the student and parent's responsibility to ensure that an instrument is purchased within these times. Hire of a College provided instrument implies acceptance of responsibility for the instrument at all times during the period of hire. The College will cover routine maintenance of the instrument; however, any accidental damage must be reported and paid for by the hirer. Parents are encouraged to arrange for purchase of an instrument if their child is keen to continue playing beyond the period of hire. Please notify the Head of Performance Music in writing if you wish to discontinue these hire arrangements to avoid unnecessary charges being incurred.
